Introduction

Hans, Helga, and their daughter Bettina were living in Weisbaden West Germany. Hans was stationed at Rhein Main Air Base. In November 1962 Hans received order to be stationed at Walker Air Force Base in Roswell New Mexico USA. Hans left in November, but Helga and Bettina did not move until December. Once in Roswell, they moved into off-base housing at 602 Redwood Street. They lived here until November 1966, when Hans received orders to be stationed in Upper Heyford, England, United Kingdom and the family moved to Banbury, England.

This compendium is different than some compendiums. Helga put together two detailed albums with plenty captions and extra information. So the first section is a recreation of these two albums as close as possible to Helga's effort.

During their time in New Mexico, Hans and Helga went on several trips within New Mexico and Mexico and these trips are included in this compendium set.

Hans and Helga were heavily involved in several hobbies and activities. Enough that these are addressed in more detail in their own compendiums or pamphlets. Examples are:

Mutter Helga fliegt mit Mann und Kind nach Amerika

Herford / Rhein - Main - Militärflughafen. Herford wird einige ihrer früheren Einwohner verlieren zugunsten der Bevölkerungszahl der Vereinigten Staaten. Hans von Schweinitz, Träger eines alten adeligen Namens, ist jetzt ein amerikanischer Bürger und dient seiner neuen Heimat als Angehöriger der Luftwaffe. Er war bis jetzt auf dem Rhein - Main - Militärflughafen stationiert und verläßt Deutschland, um ein neues Kommando in den USA zu übernehmen. Bei seiner Ausreise aus Deutschland gehen zwei weitere Herforder mit, seine hübsche junge Frau Helga (25), Tochter des verstorbenen Leiters des Schulamtes, Stadtoberinspektor Pörtner, und das Töchterchen Bettina.

Bei der Luftwaffensoldat von Schweinitz auf einer Luftwaffenbasis in Neu-Mexiko stationiert sein wird, wird die kleine Bettina viel Platz haben heranzuwachsen. Neu-Mexiko, im Südwesten der USA, ist noch nicht allzulange entfernt von der Zeit
