Date: 3May2023

Chook USH/8-5.00mm

Work in rounds, join with sl st.

Hdc and DC into back loop (BLO) unless in corner, then into gap.

Magic Ring, 8Hdc in ring, join. Mark beginning of round.

R1: Ch1, (Hdc, 3Hdc) x 4, join

R2: Ch1, (Hdc until mid loop, 3DC into gap) Repeat,

join

R3: Ch1, (Hdc until mid loop, 3DC into gap, 2Hdc in

next) Repeat, join

Repeat R3 until large enough or might need to change to (Hdc until just one before mid loop, 2Hdc, 3DC into mid loop gap, 2Hdc in next) Repeat, join

Border:

Ch1, SC in next, (sl st in next, 4DC in next, sl st in next, sc in next 2) repeat around. Adjust in corners.

Poke Me by DROPS Design Knitted cactus with seed stitch, English rib and garter stitch. The piece is worked in DROPS Merino Extra

Fine.

Cactus Small:

Measurements: Height: approx. 9 cm / $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Circumference: approx $19 \text{ cm} / 7\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Materials: DROPS MERINO EXTRA FINE from

Garnstudio (belongs to yarn group B)

50 g color 26, pistachio

The piece can also be knitted with yarn from: "Alternative yarn (Yarn Group B)" – see link below.

DROPS NEEDLES SIZE 4 MM / US 6 – or the size needed to get 21 stitches and 28 rows stockinette stitch on 10 cm / 4" in width and 10 cm / 4" in height. ACCESSORIES: Stuffing and 1 small terracotta pot (approx. 6 cm / 2 3/8" tall and 6 cm / 2 3/8" in diameter).

Cactus MEDIUM:

Measurements: Height: approx. 12 cm / 43/4".

Circumference: approx. 17 cm / 6 3/4".

Materials: DROPS MERINO EXTRA FINE from

Garnstudio (belongs to yarn group B)

50 g color 31, forest green

The piece can also be knitted with yarn from: "Alternative yarn (Yarn Group B)" – see link below.

DROPS NEEDLES SIZE 4 MM / US 6 – or the size needed to get 21 stitches and 28 rows stockinette stitch on 10 cm / 4" in width and 10 cm / 4" in height. ACCESSORIES: Stuffing and 1 small terracotta pot (approx. 6 cm / 2 3/8" tall and 6 cm / 2 3/8" in diameter).

Cactus LARGE:

Measurements: Height: approx. 14 cm / $5\frac{1}{2}$ ". Circumference: approx. 20 cm / 8" (with large and small part).

Materials:

DROPS MERINO EXTRA FINE from Garnstudio (belongs to yarn group B) 50 g color 18, green A left-over of color 30, mustard - for flower.

The piece can also be knitted with yarn from: "Alternative yarn (Yarn Group B)" – see link below.

DROPS NEEDLES SIZE 4 MM / US 6 – or the size needed to get 21 stitches and 42 rows garter stitch on 10 cm / 4" in width and 10 cm / 4" in height. ACCESSORIES: Stuffing and 1 small terracotta pot (approx. 6 cm / 2 3/8" tall and 6 cm / 2 3/8" in diameter).

Pattern instructions

NOTE: This pattern is written in American English. All measurements in charts are in cm. For conversion from inches to cm - click here. There are different terms for crocheting in American and British English. If this pattern includes crochet, click for "crochet terms" here. For this pattern in British English, please click here.

INFORMATION FOR THE PATTERN:

RIDGE/GARTER STITCH (worked back and forth): 1 ridge = Knit 2 rows.

SMALL CACTUS WITH SEED STITCH:

(next time, use medium yarn and cast 30-35 sts loosly) 7-8" wide and 30g weight

The piece is worked back and forth on needle.

Cast on 40 stitches with needle size 4 mm / US 6 and pistachio. Work * knit 1, purl 1 *, repeat from *-* to end of row. Continue working knit over purl and purl over knit - REMEMBER THE GAUGE! Continue in this way until the piece measures 9 cm / 3½". Cut the strand, pull it through the stitches together with 1 extra strand - this is to give added strength. Pull the stitches together tightly and fasten the strands well. Sew the side seam - sew edge to edge. Tack a double strand around the cast-on edge, fill the cactus with stuffing, pull together at the bottom and fasten the strands well. Place the cactus in a small terracotta pot.

MEDIUM CACTUS WITH ENGLISH RIB:

30g weight

The piece is worked back and forth on needle. Cast on 12 stitches with needle size 4 mm / US 6 and forest green. Knit 1 row (to tail) from the right side. Work the next row as follows: Knit 1, Knit 2 stitches in each of the next 11 stitches (i.e. pknit 1 stitch in the back loop of the stitch and knit 1 stitch in the front loop of the stitch) = 23 stitches. REMEMBER THE GAUGE!

Continue with English rib as follows:

ROW 1: (to tail) Work * knit 1, 1 yarn over, slip 1 stitch as if to purl *, repeat from *-* until there is 1 stitch left, finish with knit 1.

ROW 2: (away) * 1 yarn over, slip 1 stitch as if to purl, knit together the yarn over and the slipped stitch *, repeat from *-* until there is 1 stitch left, finish with 1 yarn over, slip 1 stitch as if to purl.

Row 2 (away) my version: *1 yarn over, slip 1 stitch purl, (Knit tog below next st and yo)*, end with yarn over, slip 1 st purl.

ROW 3: (to tail) * Knit together the yarn over and slipped stitch, 1 yarn over, slip 1 stitch as if to purl *, repeat from *-* until there are 2 stitches left, knit together the yarn over and the slipped stitch. Row 3 (to tail) my version: *(Knit tog below next st and yo) 1yo, slip 1 stitch purl *, when 2 left then Ktog below next st & yo.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 upwards.

When the piece measures 12 cm / 43/4" (next time go to 5.5"), purl 1 row from the wrong side. Work the next row as follows: Knit 1, knit the remaining stitches

together 2 and 2 [end with 12 sts]. Cut the strand, pull it through all the stitches [12], together with 1 extra strand - this is to give added strength. Pull the stitches together and fasten the strands well.

Sew the side seam - sew edge to edge in the outermost loop of the outermost stitch. Tack a double strand around the cast-on edge, fill the cactus with stuffing, pull together at the bottom and fasten the strands well. Place the cactus in a small terracotta pot.

LARGE CACTUS WITH GARTER STITCH:

30g weight

You work 1 large part and 1 small part (with flower), these are sewn together at the end.

LARGE PART:

The piece is worked back and forth on needle. Cast on 29 stitches with needle size 4 mm / US 6 and green. Work GARTER STITCH - see description above. REMEMBER THE GAUGE! bind off when the piece measures 10 cm / 4".

Sew the cast-on and bind-off edges together, edge to edge in the outermost loop of the outermost stitch. Tack a double strand around the whole of one side, pull together at the top and fasten the strands well. Fill with stuffing and sew together the other side in the same way.

SMALL PART:

The piece is worked back and forth on the needle. Cast on 18 stitches with needle size 4 mm / US 6 and green. Work 10 ridges [each ridge = 2rows, do for 20rows or 2.75"). Bind off.

Sew together and fill with stuffing in the same way as the large part. Sew the small part to the large part with a couple of stitches at the bottom edge.

FLOWER:

Cast on 3 stitches with needle size 4 mm / US 6 and a left-over of mustard.

ROW 1: Knit 1, 1 yarn over, knit 1, 1 yarn over and knit 1 = 5 stitches.

ROW 2: Knit - the yarn overs are knitted twisted to prevent holes.

ROW 3: Knit 1, * 1 yarn over, knit 1 *, repeat from *- * to end of row = 9 stitches.

ROW 4: Knit, the yarn overs are knitted twisted to prevent holes.

6: ch2, hdc into back loop, in spiral, want ridges to outside. Repeat row 6 until high enough about 6 rows

* Pass the 2nd stitch over the first stitch on the needle (= 1 stitch less) *, repeat from *-* until there is 1 stitch left on the needle. Cut the strand and pull it through the last stitch, pull tight to a small ball. Tack a strand around the opening, pull tight and fasten well. Sew the flower onto the end of the small part.

7: sc into back of posts8: hdc into sam post from 7 (causes ridge to front)Bind off.

Place the cactus in a small terracotta pot.

C-hook 6/G

Material is yarn and ribbon together

(Next time double the yarn for strength)

Magic circle

1: ch1, sc7, join with sl st [8]

2: ch2, 2hdc into each sc below, join with sl st [16] (hdc into both top loops)

3: ch2, (hdc, 3hdc) repeat, join with sl st (hdc into both top loops)

4: do this row for medium and large pot. Ch2 (hdc2, 2hdc) repeat, join with sl st (hdc into both top loops) 5: ch2, hdc around post, join with sl st, turn inside out to expose ridge.

c-hook smallest possible for small stiches. E-4US/3.50mm

3.5" by 2.75" and 40g

Abbreviations:

Mr, sc n = magic ring - crochet n (number) single crochet stitches into the adjustable loop

Sc single crochet stitch

Sc n = crochet n single crochet stitches, one in each stitch.

4: (sc 5, inc) x 3 [21]

5: sc 2, inc, (sc 6, inc) x 2, sc 4 [24]

6: (sc 7, inc) x 3 [27]

7: sc 3, inc, (sc 8, inc) x 2, sc 5 [30]

8: (sc 9, inc) x 3 [33]

9: sc in each stitch [33]

10: sc 4, inc, (sc 10, inc) x 2, sc 6 [36]

11-15: for 5 rows, sc in each stitch [36]

16: (sc 10, dec) x 3 [33]

17: sc 4, dc, (sc 9, dec) x 2, sc 5 [30]

Start stuffing the egg. Keep adding a bit of fiber fill after every couple of round, stuffing the egg firmly.

18: (sc 3, dec) x 6 [24]

19: (dec, sc 2) x 6 [18]

20: (sc, dec) x 6 [12]

21: dec x 6 [6]

Finish stuffing. Cut the yar, leaving a long yarn tail, and fasten off. Thread the tail into a needle and use it to pick up the front loops of the remaining stiches and close the opening.



C-hook H-8US/5.00mm

Ch: chain st, sl st slip stitch, sc single crochet, hdc half double crochet, dc double crochet, tr triple crochet

When you make crocheted flowers, the petals are created in rounds as you go. For three-dimensional flowers such as these, it's a two-step process. You start with the petals in the center, then crochet chain loops behind these petals in the second round. On the third pass around, you crochet the actual petals in the chain loops from the previous row. You just keep working in this fashion until all petals round are completed.

Center ring, Ch2

Round 1: (2sc, 2hdc, 2dc, tr) in 2nd ch from hook, slst in first sc to join (7sts)

Round 2: working BEHIND sts just made and into center ring, ch3, skip first 2 sts, sl st between last skipped st and next st, ch3, skip next 2 sts, sl st between last skipped st and next st, ch3, skip next st, sl st between last skipped st and next st, ch3, skip next st, sl st between last skipped st and next st, ch3, skip next st, sl st between last skipped st and next st, ch 3, sl st in first ch to join (5ch-3 loops)

Round 3: Sl st in first ch-3loop, ch 1, (sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc) in loop, *sl st in next loop, ch 1, (sc, hdc, dc, hdc, sc) in loop*, rep from * to * around, sl st in first sl st to join (5 petals made).

Round 4: working BEHIND sts just made and into ch-3 loops of Round 2, skip first 2 sts on first petal, *sl st between last skipped st and next st, ch 3, skip next 3 sts on current petal and next 2 sts on next petal*, repeat from * to * around, sl st in first sl st to join (5 ch - 3 loops)

Round 5: SI st in first ch-3loop, ch 1, (sc, hdc, 3dc, hdc, sc) in loop, *sI st in next loop, ch1, (sc, hdc, 3dc, hdc, sc) in loop*, repeat from * to * around, sI st in first sI st to join (5 petals made)

Round 6: workding BEHIND sts just made and into ch-3 loops of round 4, skip first 3 sts on first petal, *sl st between last skipped st and next st, ch 3, skip next 4 sts on current petal and next 3 sts on next petal*, repeat from * to * around, sl st in first sl st to join (5ch -2 loops).

Round 7: Sl st in first ch-3 loop, ch 1, (sc, hdc, 5dc, hdc, sc) in loop, *sl st in next loop, ch 1, (sc, hdc, 5dc, hdc, sc) in loop*, repeat from * to * around, sl st in first sl st to join (5 petals made).

Fasten off.

Crochet hook I/9-5.50mm or 6.00mm

Round 1: Magic circle, Ch 2, HDC 10 into circle, join = 11 st

Round 2: 1ch, 10(sc2 into each top loop pair), join = 22st.

Round 3: 2 Ch, 21(HDC into each top loop pair), join = 22st

Round 4-7: for 4 rounds repeat round 3

Bind off, and tuck in ends.

To fit glasses at Conservatory, top needs to be 4.5" wide and height 4 to 4.5"

Note: When picking up stitches, if the hole looks too loose make the stitch with the yarn from the row below which is tighter. Use crochet hook to pick up stiches.

Direction:

Color A (green) cast on 20st. Knit 24 garter ridges (ridge = two rows), end on WS row.

Next Row (RS): cast off all sts until last st (keep this st live), turn the work clockwise to the long side. Cut A leaving a 6" tail.

Attach color B (yellow), knit the live st, pick up and knit one st for ever garter ridge (it is easiest to pick up the st in the valley between the garter ridge).

Knit with color B (yellow) until 9 full garter ridges and finish on RS. K 2 more rows.

Next Row (RS): cast off all sts until the last st, leave the last st live. Cut B leaving a 6" tail. Turn Clockwise to next side for color C (pink).

Attach color C (pink), knit the live sts, pick up and knit one st for every garter ridge, when you get to the A (green) square pick up and knit 1 st for every st. Work same as B (yellow)

Continue for another 13 blocks (total 16 blocks) or until blanket at desired size.

Markers qty 8 (one a different color for start of round) Kfb: an increase: knit in front and back of each stitch. Starting with 4 double-pointed needles

1: Cast 8 stitches, slide 2 sts onto each needle.

2: join yarn, knit a foundation roud *k1, kfb* (12 sts total) Each kneedle has three sts.

3: another round as follows: K1, place odd colored marker [k1, pm, k2, pm] 3 times, k1, pm k1 You should know have a marker on EACH side of the middle stitch on EACH kneedle. The odd color marker indicates the beginning of each round.

4: continue as follows

Row 1: *K to stitch before 1st marker, kfb, sm, k1, sm, kfb* repeat * to * until back at odd color stitch Row 2: K to end, slipping markers as you go.

Each increase round will add 8 stitches. Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until blanket is desired size. Switch to circular kneedles.

Fasten off.

Finish: Thread 14 inch tail on to needle with right side facing together, beginning with first petal, start to roll flower as if you are making a spiral and secure as you go with the stitches on the bottom of the flower.




