Introduction

I have always admired Vincent van Gogh. Ever since I learned that he began his drawing/painting career at age 27 (1880). The "Carpenter" from 1880 is at my level of drawing. Vincent van Gogh died at age 37 (1853-1890). In those 10 years he created 2100 artworks, 860 were oil paintings. When his creations are put in chronological order, I can see how he learned from mentors and how he absorbed the sciences.

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Biography: Short

Vincent Willem van Gogh was a Dutch Post-Impressionist painter who is among the most famous and influential figures in the history of Western art. In just over a decade, he created approximately 2100 artworks, including around 860 oil paintings, most of them in the last two years of his life. Wikipedia






Fig. 1-5. Vincent Van Gogh (1853-1890), Carpenter (1880). Courtesy of Rijksmuseum Kröller-Müller, Otterlo.

Van Gogh worked as an artist only during the last ten years of his life, from the age of 27 until he died at 37. During the first two years of that decade, Van Gogh did drawings only, teaching himself how to draw. As you can see in the drawing of the *Carpenter*, he struggled with problems of proportion and placement of forms. By 1882, however — two years later — in his *Woman Mourning*, Van Gogh had overcome his difficulties with drawing and increased the expressive quality of his work.



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
December 1883 Garden of the Vicarage in Nuenen in Winter

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

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

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

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
Closeup of "upside down Ladies" in November 1889 Olive Grove

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


June 1890 Two Pear Trees with the Chateau Jun




Close-up of "squirrel" 1889 Orchard in Bloom in Arles in the Background

The brilliant colors, explosive brushwork, and emotional intensity of Vincent van Gogh's paintings make them some of the best-known images in art. Yet during his short lifetime (1853–1890), Van Gogh was never fully appreciated. This catalog presents 70 paintings from the collection of the Van Gogh Museum, Amsterdam, home to the greatest assemblage of the artist's paintings, drawings, and letters. The collection is based on works acquired from the artist by his brother Theo, an art dealer and the source of Vincent's financial and emotional support. All periods of Van Gogh's career are represented through reproductions of many of his greatest and most iconic paintings, along with less well-known treasures. The catalog includes an essay on the artist's major themes and the different phases of his career, a history of the museum, and a short biography of the artist.

The exhibition is organized by the National Gallery of Art, Washington, and the Van Gogh Museum, Amsterdam, in collaboration with the Los Angeles County Museum of Art.

The exhibition is supported by an indemnity from the Federal Council on the Arts and the Humanities.

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

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
