Introduction

Hans-Ludwig von Schweinitz put several different albums together with photos of his family and friends. In letters and his autobiography, he mentioned several people. When I wrote his biography and historical biography, I added many more.

This compendium attempts to identify these people and when possible provide a photo. In January 1945, the family had to flee their estate in Silesia, Alt Raudten (to avoid the Red Russian Army) and many family heirlooms were left behind. The family was never able to return to the estate. These photos were the few that they did take with them on the flight, or from Hans-Ludwig intense search of albums from other family members that had left the estate at an earlier date. When possible, the photo closest to 1945 is used. For some family members and friends the only photo is a group photo from a wedding. These wedding photos are in the compendium "Hans photos pre 1945 Compendium"







Tresckow masterminded the 20 July 1944 assassination plot against Hitler "Valkyrie". Hitler was only injured. On 21 July 1944, General von Tresckow committed suicide in order to protect other conspirators and his own family.
