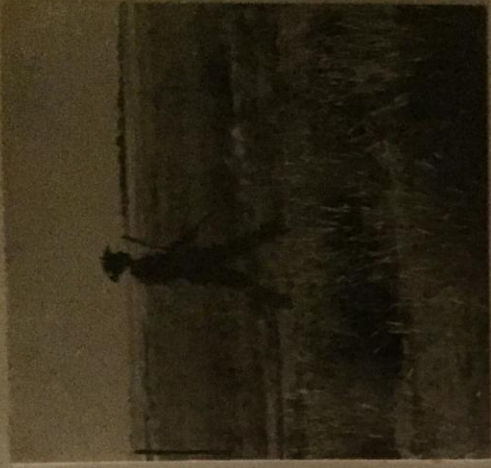

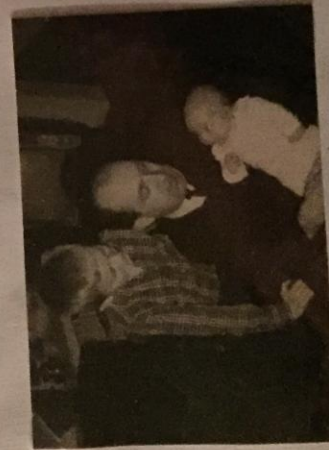

Sgt. Hans Von Schweinitz with their equipment had discovered two pits during a superficial excavation. They explored the pits to a depth of about 50 feet, noting that both pits had a very hard drop.

A force of seven members of the Peconic Valley Grotto was organized for a second trip

A Russell team, Barry Kooner was the third member of the party when the cave was found during a recent surface exploration expedition for the National Speleological Society in the Guadalupe Mountains, west of Carlsbad National Park, N.M.

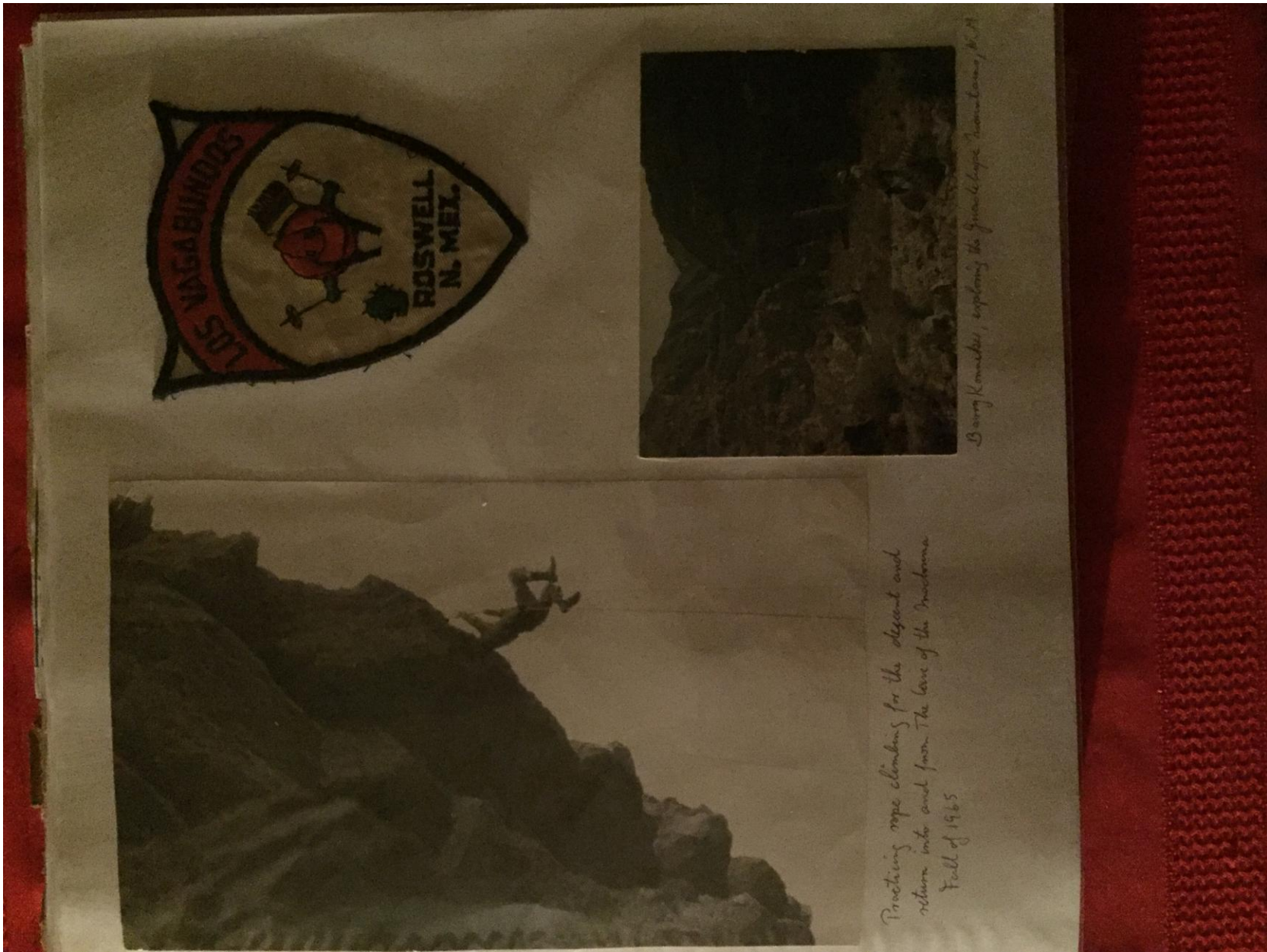
Exploring was being done to enable all caves in the area for the organization and the small child slung against the darkness of a small grotto. This brought about their decision to remain in the Cave of the Madonna.

Explorers Davis and Koser named the larger of the two pits the "Tuff's Crater," a German name meaning Devil's Pit. It was explained to a ledge that it was exposed to a ledge that it was found to be 175 feet from the bottom, by one of ropes with a heavy object tied to the end. This was done to determine their depth. The distance they had descended from the opening in the crater counts area, results in the 256 foot vertical depth figure.

Arman Davis, smallest of the three, explained the conspiracy's formation, broadly in the spirit chamber, when the group passed the laydown on their first trip to the cave. "Remember, the best way to get to the cave is the open road, and that's the only way, and that's the only way," he said, pointing to the lower chamber.

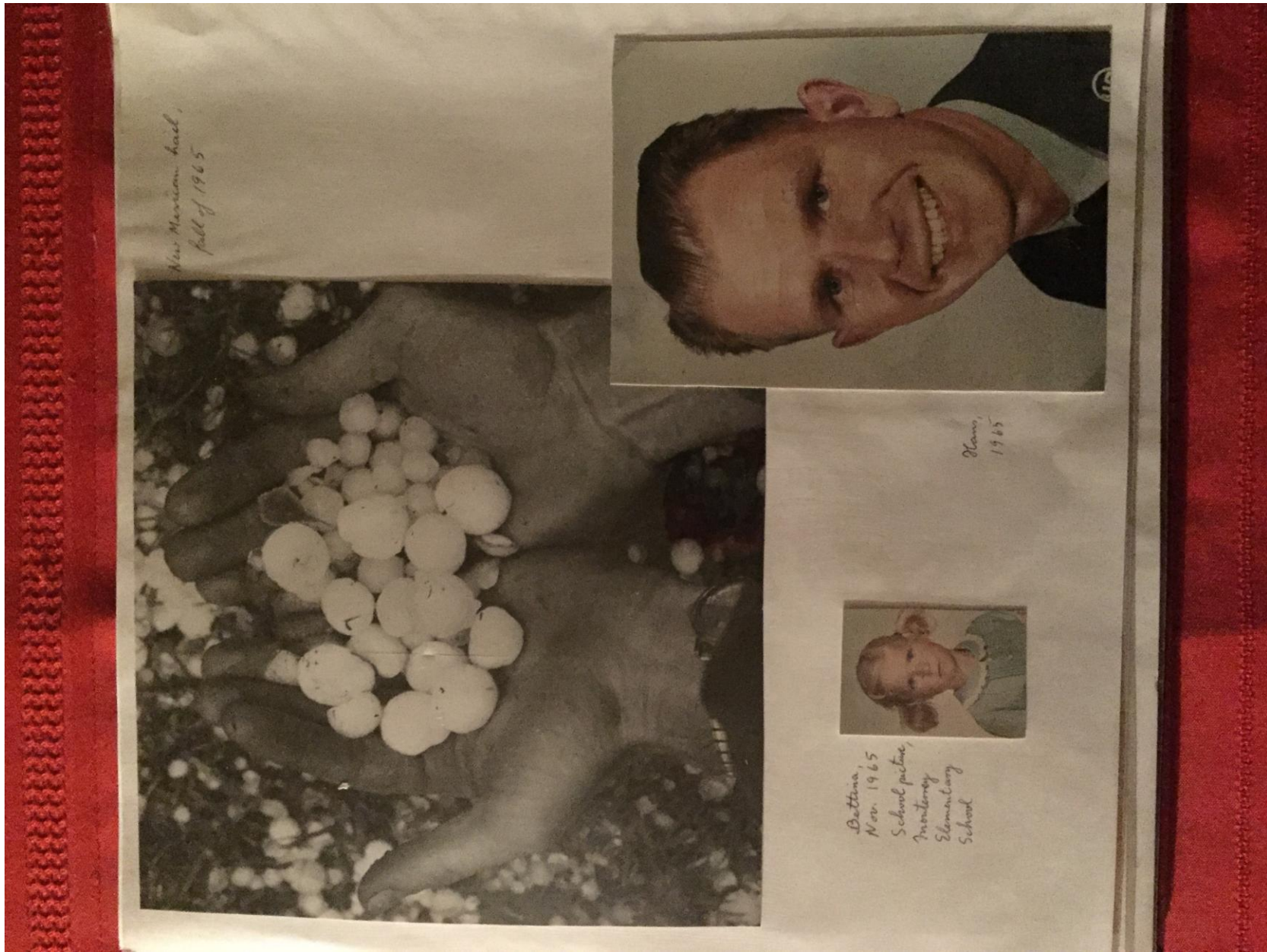

## 7 Given Oaths Of Citizenship

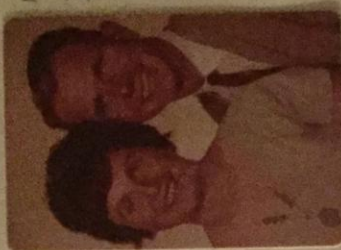
Russell can count seven grand-jury Americans among a populace as the result of citizenship oaths administered Thursday by Judge George L. Scott, Jr., in Fifth District court.

# Plane in search for missing man

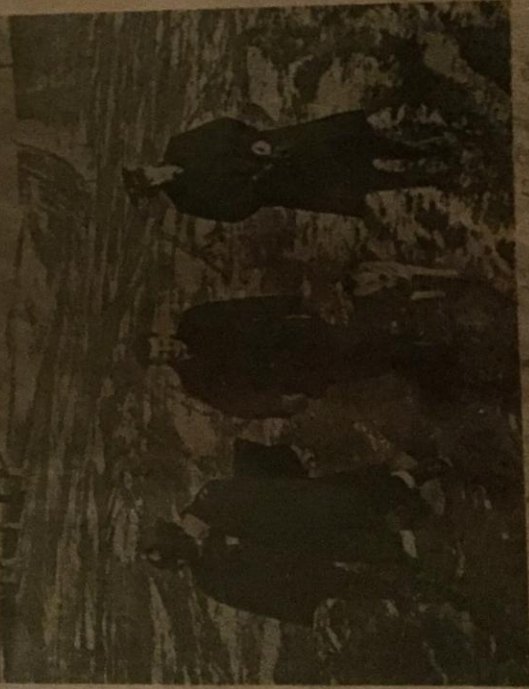

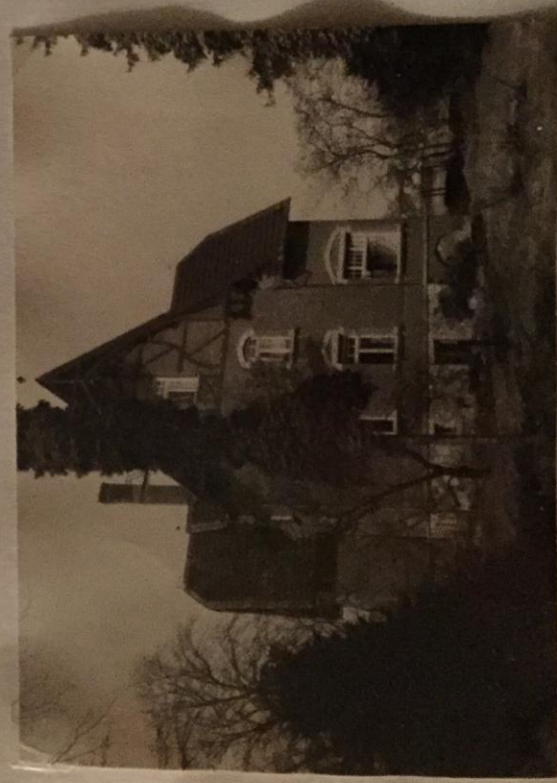
